Who: students (PT & PTA), faculty, residents, and clinicians can submit

When: The 2016 WPTA Spring Conference will host the annual poster presentations on Thursday, April 14th (afternoon).

Types: Basic Science, Applied Science, or Case Report/Study

Submission Deadline: March 4, 2016

Email abstract form (as attachment) to jgreany@uwlax.edu

* Subject line: WPTA Poster session_[school]_[last name of primary presenter]

Review process: After a peer review process, abstracts will be selected (space limitations at conference). Notifications will be sent via email approximately 1-2 weeks after the deadline.

Posters will be judged and 1st and 2nd places will be awarded at the awards reception.

Posters must be in place by noon on Thursday April 14, 2016 for judging.

Preparing the Abstract

- We strongly suggest that you begin your submission in advance.
- The body of your abstract should be no more than 2,300 characters, including punctuation (not spaces).
- Use standard abbreviations. When using abbreviations, spell out in full for the first mention, followed by the abbreviation in parentheses. Do not abbreviate in the abstract title.

Submission

- **Author** - List all authors who contributed to the work discussed in the abstract. The presenting author must be identified as the primary author.
- **Title** - Write your title in sentence case (first letter of the first word is capitalized; remaining letters are lower case). Do not bold or italicize your full title.
- **Abstract** - Enter the body of the abstract in the space provided. Use Arial or Calibri, font size 10 or larger.
- The abstract should include the following sections:
 - Introduction
 - Purpose
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Discussion
 - Conclusion(s)/clinical relevance
