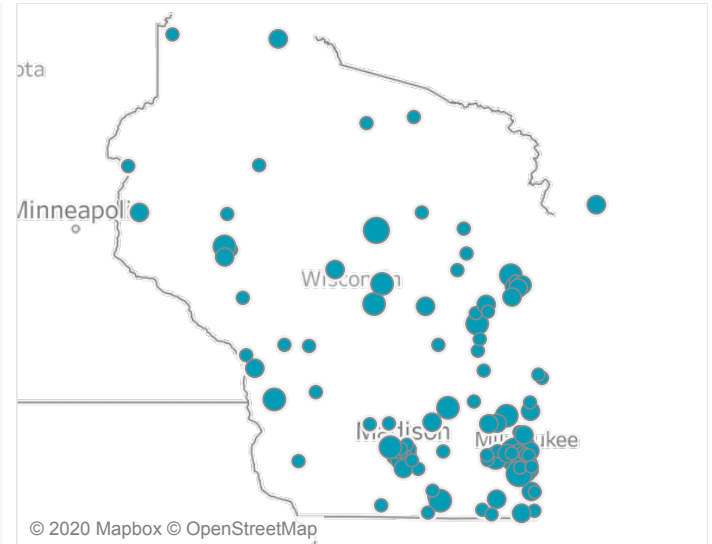

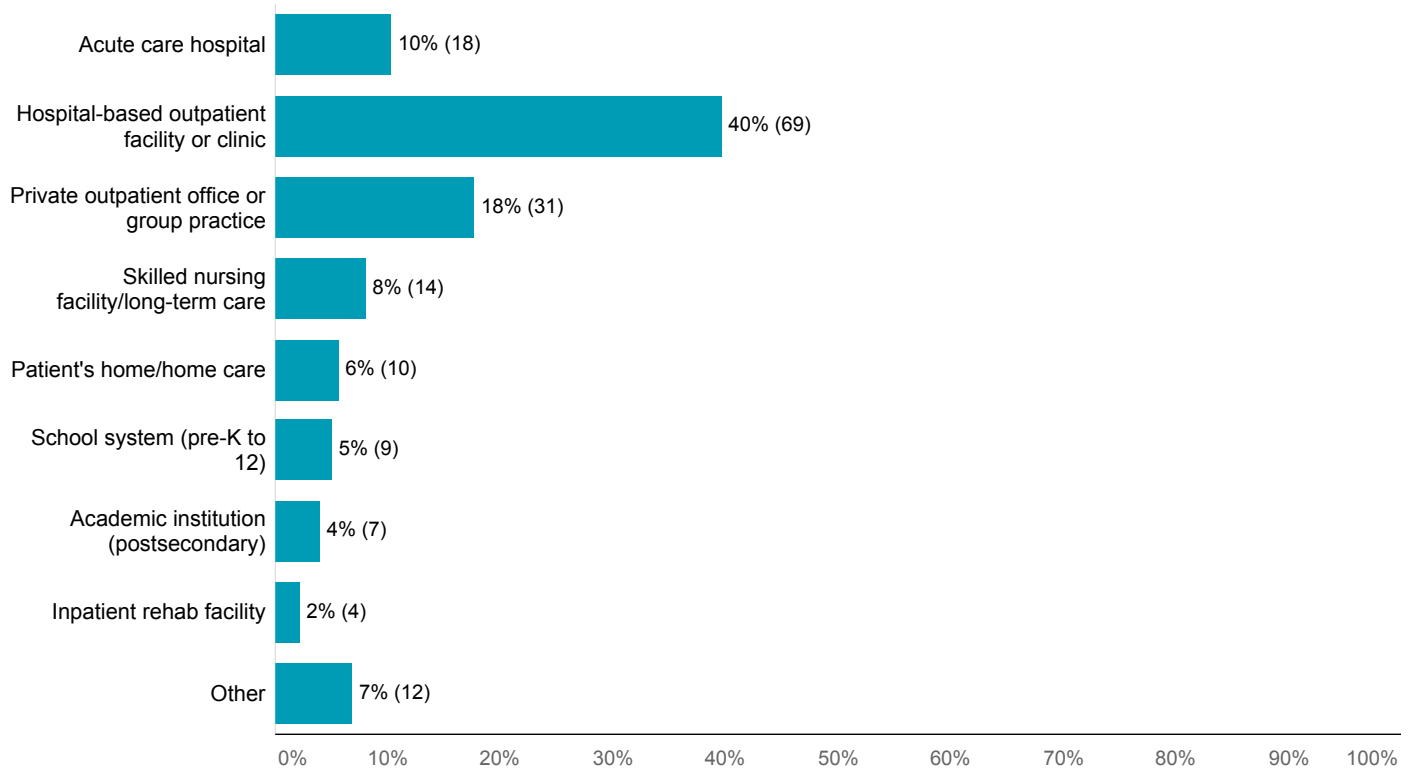

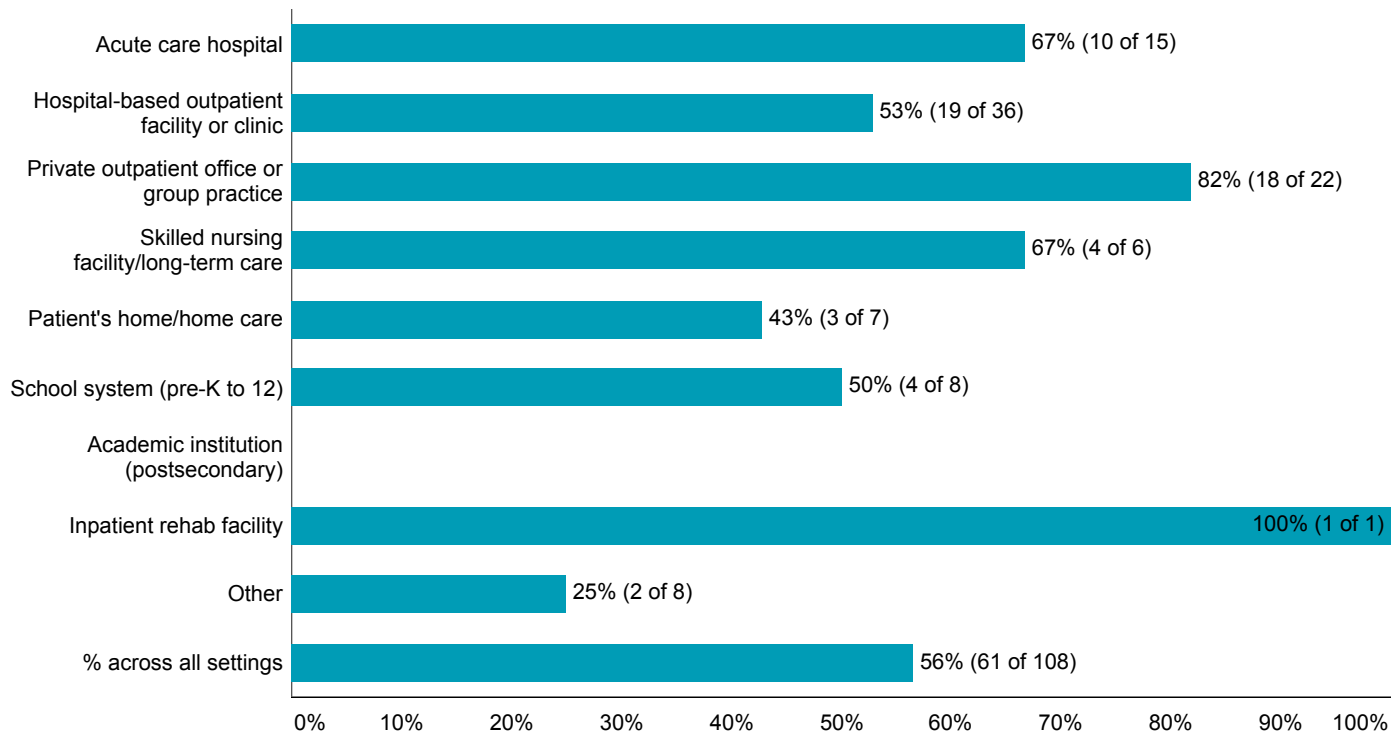

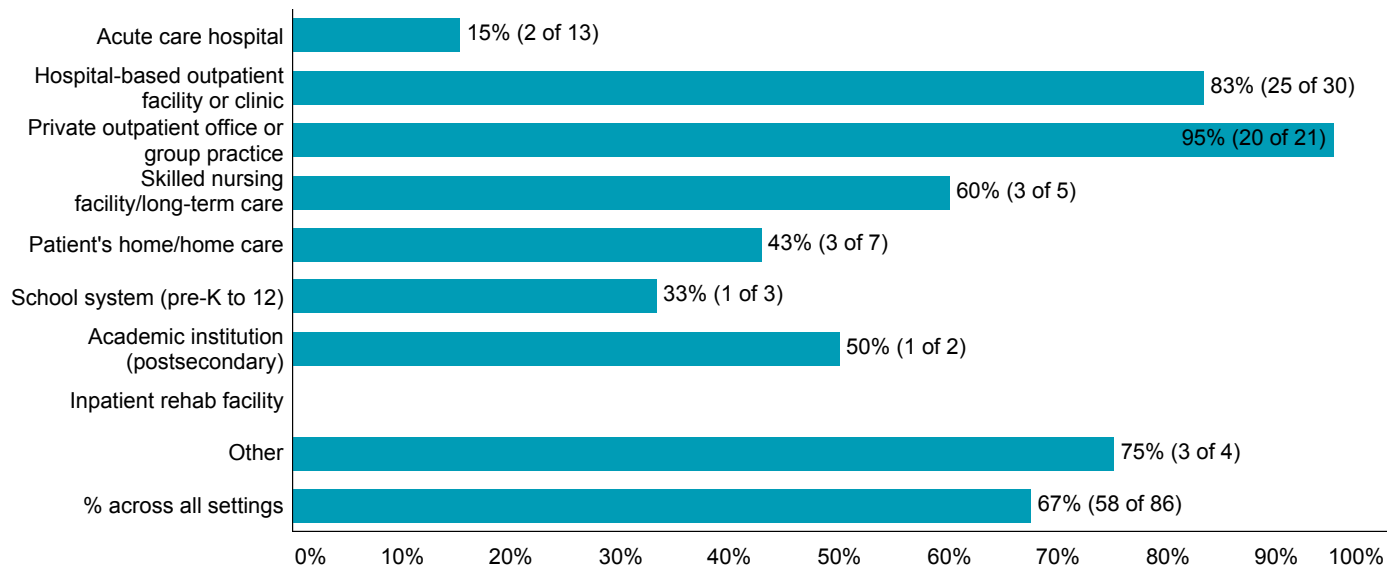
Percent of PTs Whose Work Hours Declined

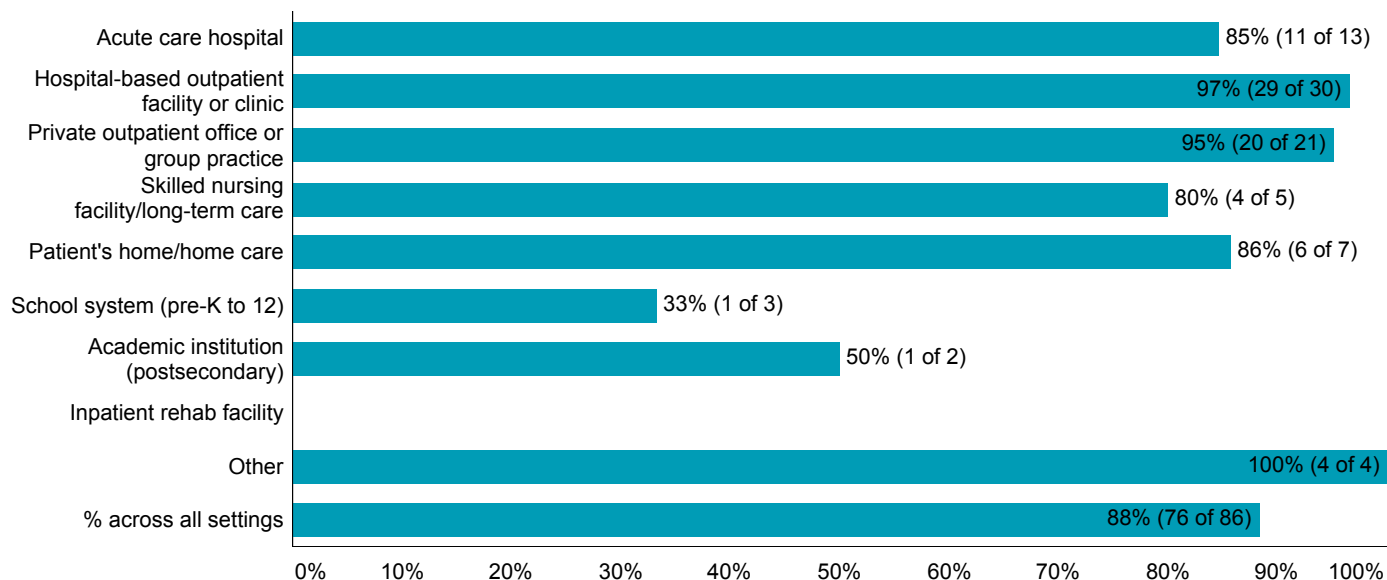
Percent of PTs Whose Caseload of Direct Patients Declined

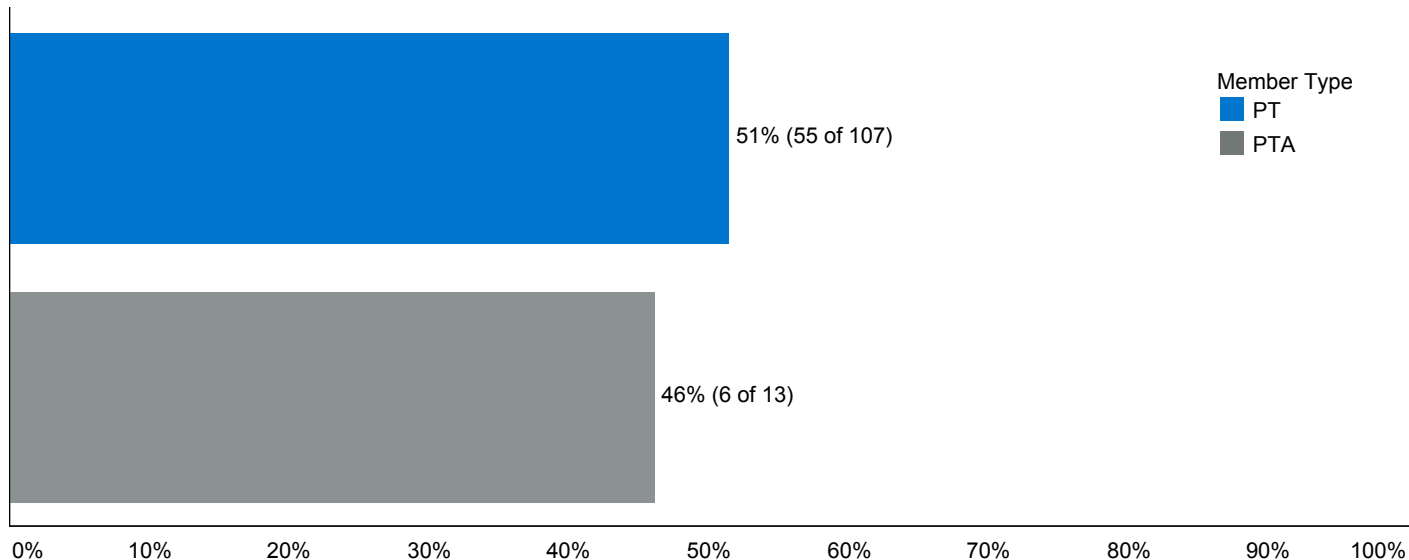
Percent of PTs Whose Caseload of Physician-Referred Patients Declined

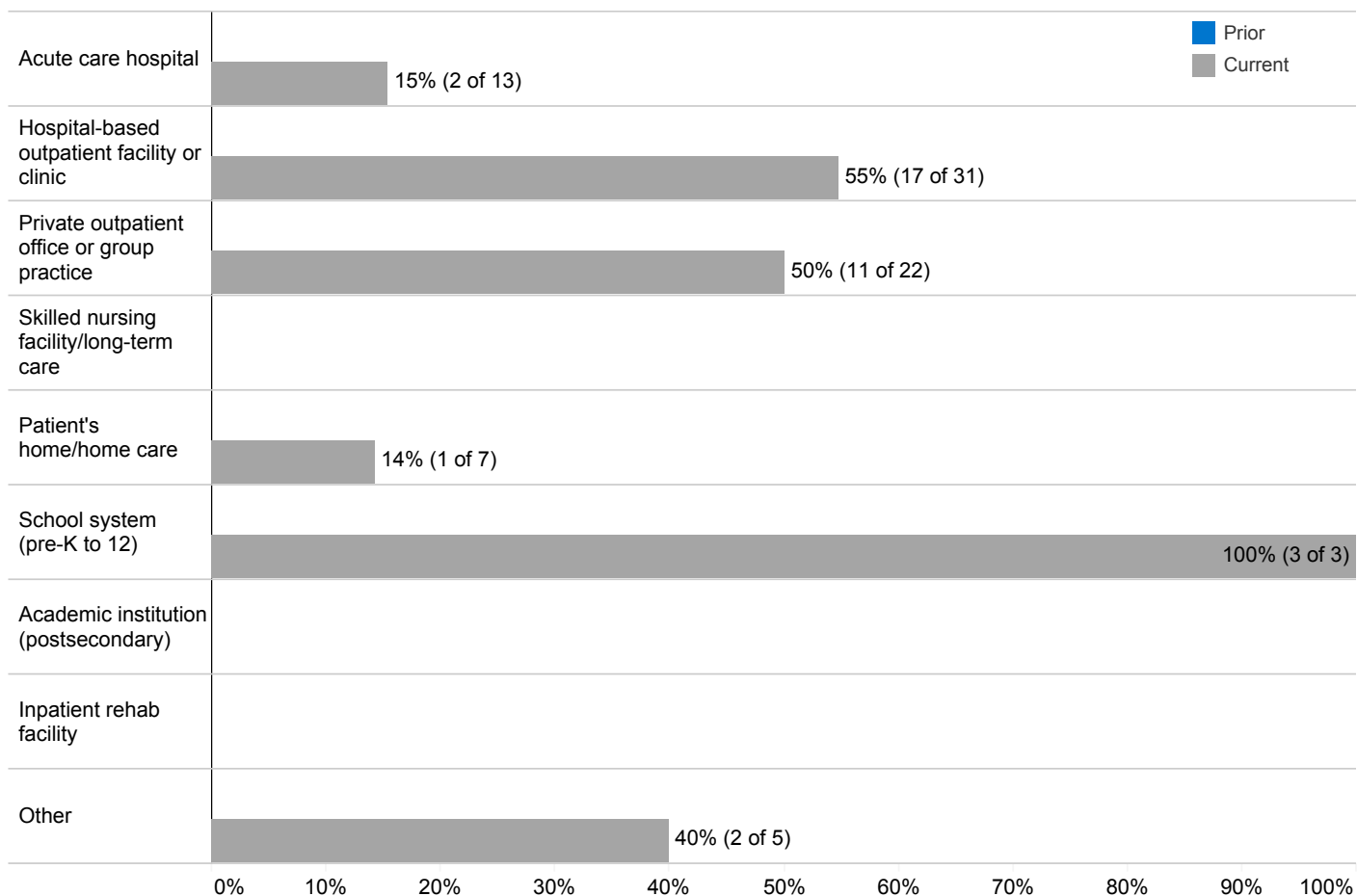

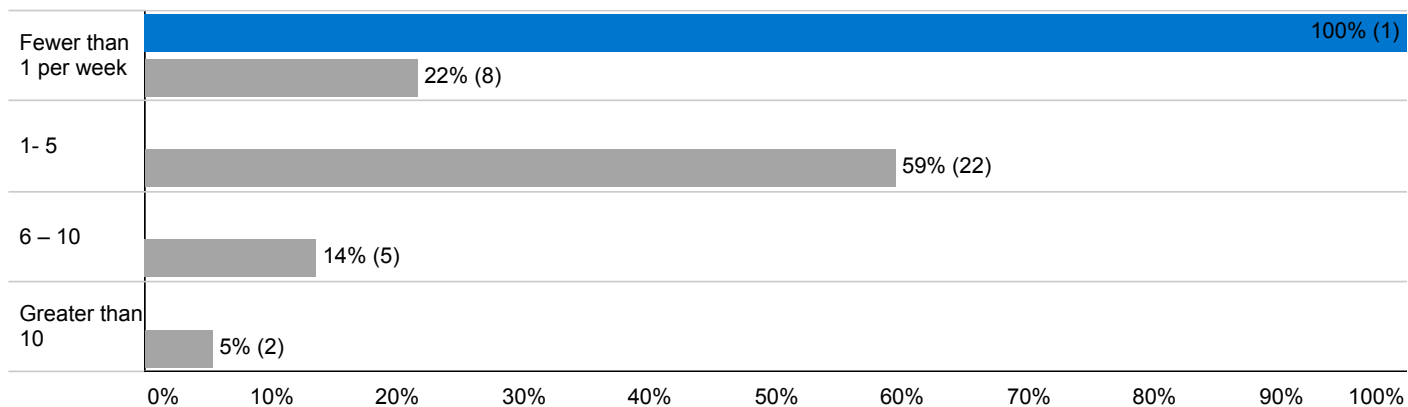

Average Patients Treated per Week Via Live Video Consult

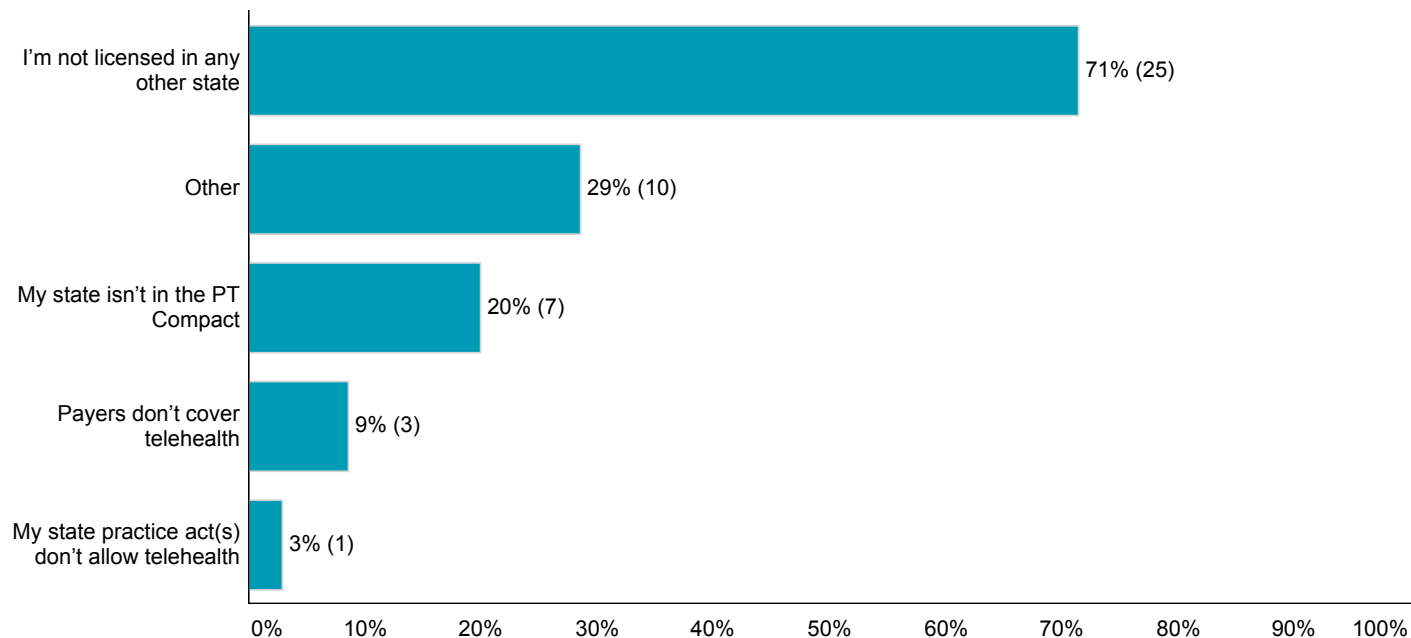

Note: 0 respondents indicated that they were treating patients via live video consult prior to the pandemic and 36 indicated that they are currently treating patients via live video consult.

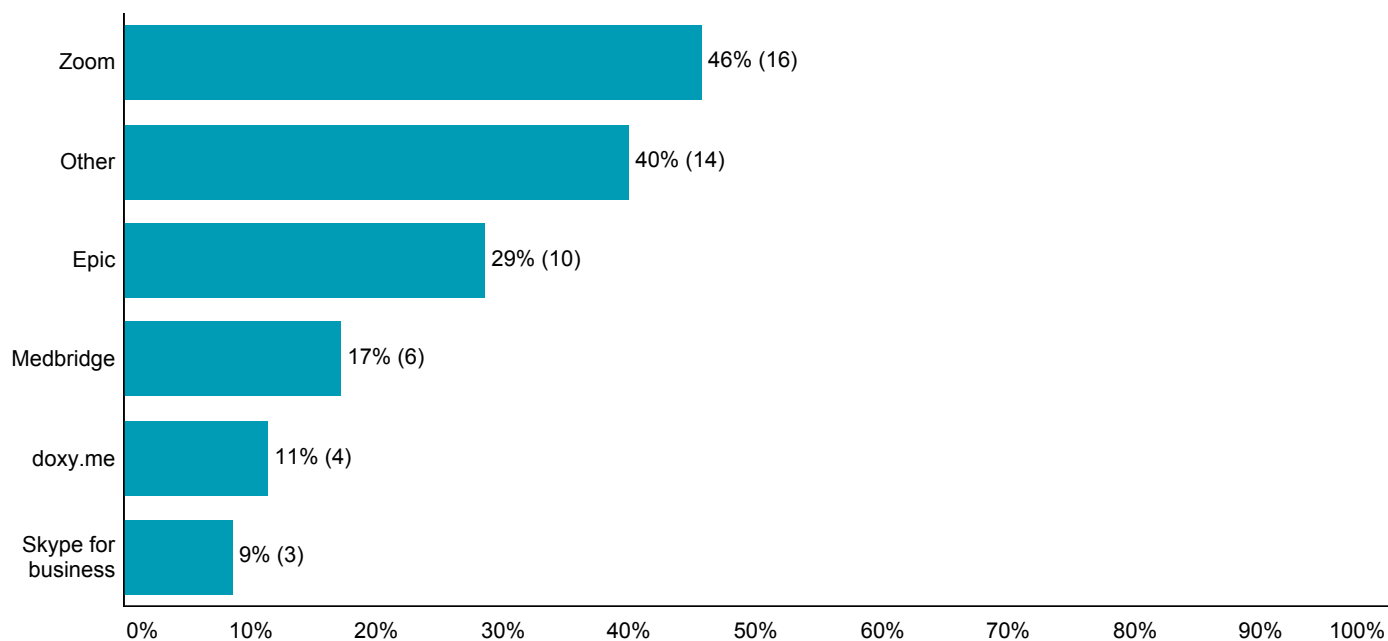
Reasons for PTs Not Providing Telehealth Across State Lines

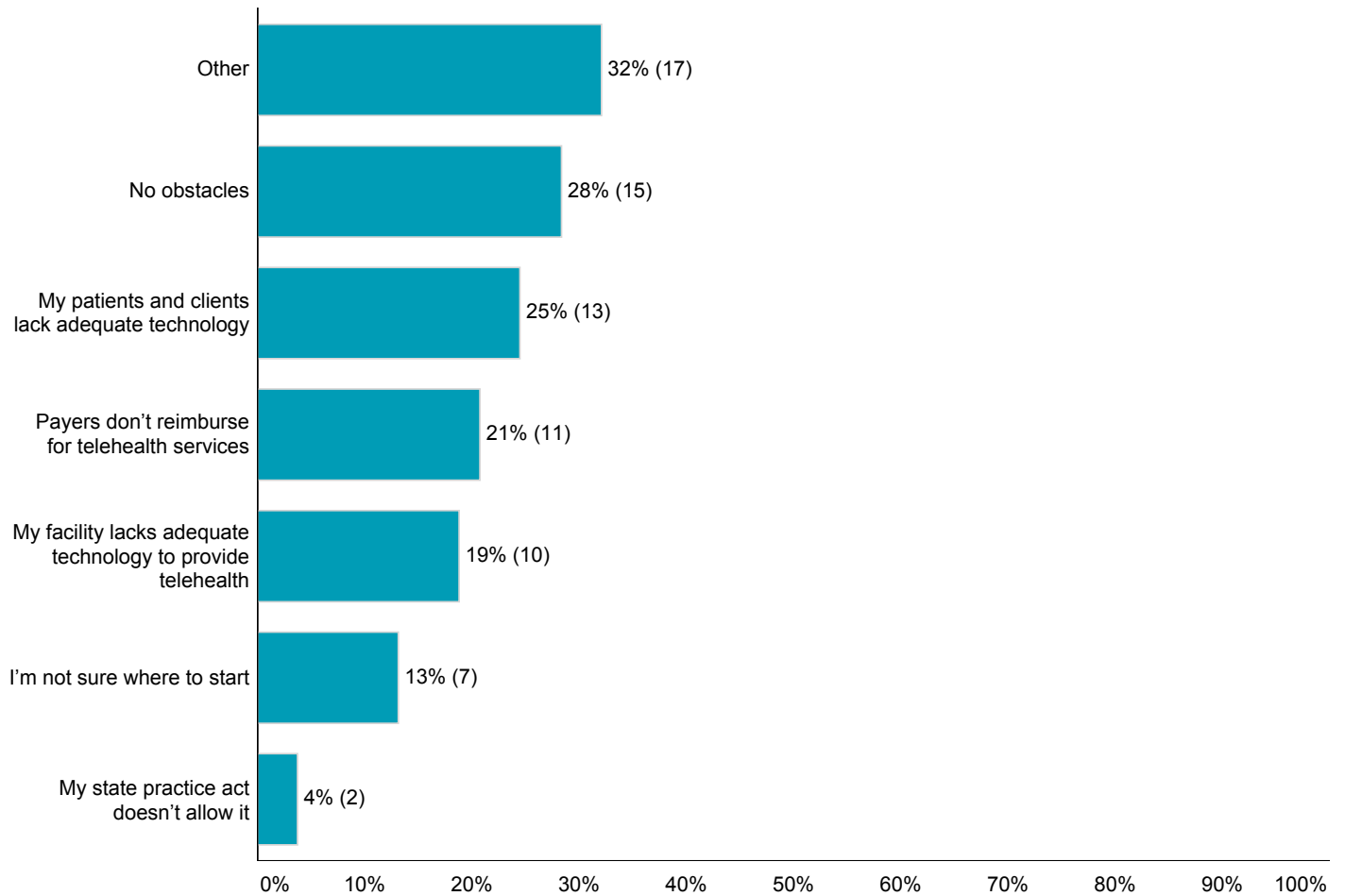
Telehealth Platforms Being Utilized by PTs

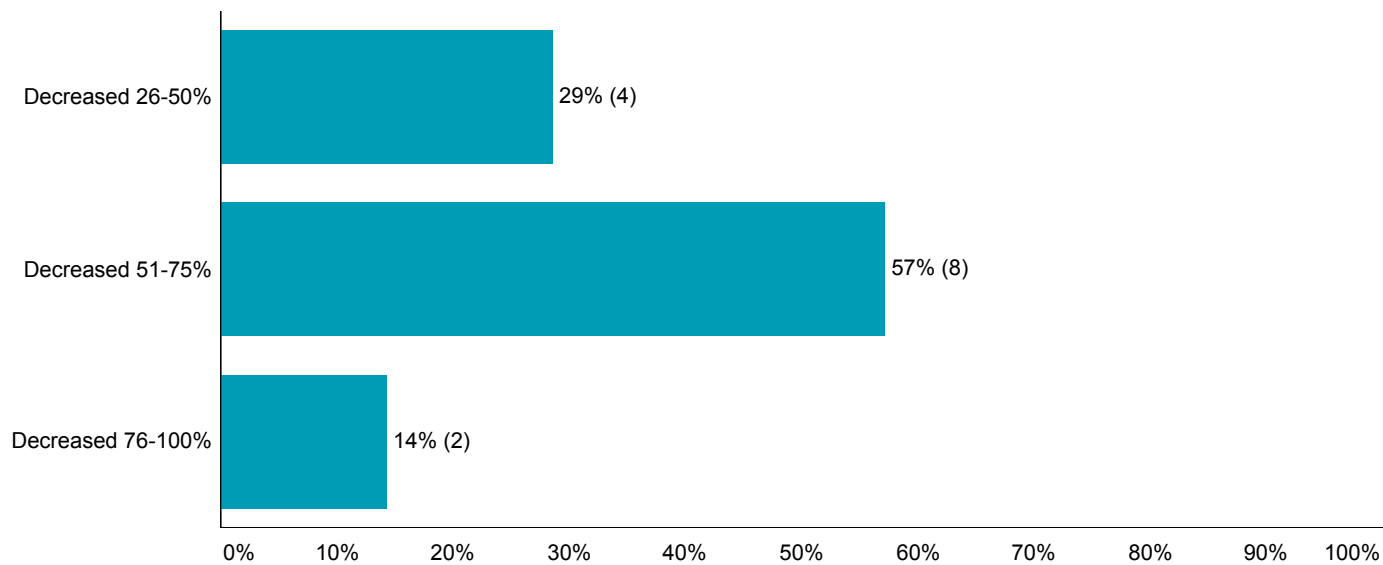
PTs Obstacles to Providing Telehealth
